### Tips on entering CLASS 101, 'Club Growing and Showing'

- 1. The Space** allowed for the display on a table is 1.8m long and 0.75m wide. The height of the display is limited by the height of the marquee wall which is approx 2.75m. It is important to keep within these measurements as to have anything protruding or hanging outside these limits may lead to disqualification.
- 2. Quality.** Everything in the exhibit should be of good quality but there is no need for it to be of the same standard as required for the competitive classes. Good cut flower size and culinary produce.
- 3. Cleanliness.** In exhibiting, cleanliness is next to “Godliness”. Flowers and pot plants should be free of pest and pest damage, pots clean, vegetables washed and any bad foliage removed. Fruit should be ripe for eating or mature if for cooking.
- 4. Range.** A wide a range of produce should be displayed but each type should not be too bold or too little. Too much of any one type, just to fill space, would lose marks.
- 5. Effect.** A balanced eye catching display is required with a strong focal point. Accessories are permitted but should not take the eye. Pots should be hidden, remember it’s an exhibit of produce!
- 6. Planning.** Plan ahead and at least have a main idea for the display. Do not turn up with lots of produce and try to make up the display at the Show.
